

IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR THE 3RD CYCLE UPR RECOMMENDATIONS (2021-2025)

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BACKGROUND

The Universal Periodic Review (UPR) is a peer review mechanism of the United Nations Human Rights Council (HRC) that examines the human rights performance of all United Nations member states, once every four and a half years. The UPR was created through the UN General Assembly on 15 March 2006 by resolution 60/251, which established the Human Rights Council itself. The ultimate goal of the UPR is to improve the human rights situation in all countries. The reviews are conducted by the UPR Working Group which consists of the 47 members of the Council. During the review, recommendations are made to the State under review aimed at ensuring the full realization of human rights by its people.

Kenya's human rights record was reviewed for the 3rd time under the Universal Periodic Review Process in January 2020 during the 35th session of the UPR Working Group. During the interactive dialogue session, 118 delegations made statements and Kenya received 319 recommendations. Out of these 263 received support and 56 were noted. To ensure proper implementation of the accepted recommendations a comprehensive implementation plan has been developed.

This implementation plan outlines the tasks to be undertaken to implement the UPR recommendations, indicators to monitor the progress made; responsible actors for each task, including CSOs and development partners; and timelines within which the tasks should be undertaken and completed. The implementation plan covers the period 2021- 2025.
