HUMAN RIGHTS DIVISION FUNCTIONS

Objective

To provide expertise and services on human rights matters.

Functions

This Division shall perform the following functions:

- 1. To develop human rights policies;
- 2. To carry out review of domestic laws to ensure compliance with existing International and Regional instruments on human rights;
- 3. To ensure state compliance with human rights obligations;
- 4. To facilitate the ratification of international and regional instruments on human rights;
- 5. To oversee the development of human rights regime;
- 6. To supervise policy framework for human rights implementation;
- 7. To liaise with the Office of the Attorney General and Solicitor General on matters relating to advice and human rights issu
- 8. To analyses and advise on different reports submitted by the Commission of Human Rights and Good Governance and other non- state actors on human rights on related areas;
- 9. To coordinate matters related to access to information; and
- 10. To coordinate the preparation and submission of country report on different thematic areas by the implementing ministries, departments and agencies.

This Division led by a Director and will comprise two (2) sections as follows:

- (i) Human Rights Reporting Section; and
- (ii) Implementation Observatory Section.

Human Rights Reporting Section

This Section shall perform the following activities:

- 1. Develop human rights policies;
- 2. Disseminate concluding observations from human rights treaty bodies;
- 3. Prepare national reports for presentation before human rights bodies;
- 4. Facilitate the ratification of International and Regional instruments on humanrights;

- 5. Liaise with the Office of the Attorney General and Solicitor General on matters relating to advice and human rights cases; and
- 6. Prepare country reports on human rights in accordance with regional and international agreements.

This Section led by an Assistant Director.

Implementation Observatory Section

This Section performs the following hactivities: -

- 1. Ensure state compliance with human rights obligations;
- 2. Oversee the development of human rights regime;
- 3. Establish and develop a comprehensive policy framework for human rights implementation;
- 4. Liaise with the Office of the Attorney General and Solicitor General on matters relating to advice and human rights matters;
- 5. Carry out review of domestic laws to ensure compliance with existing International and Regional instruments on human rights;
- 6. Follow up matters related to access to information; and
- 7. sensitize public officials on human rights matters.

This Section led by an Assistant Director
